**Tree types:** standard trees, feathered trees | **Topiary:** column

### USE

**Location:** street, avenue, park, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** columnar | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

**Flowers:** catkins, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** golden yellow, buds yellow | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, wide, polished, slightly hairy, undulate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** edible, small, spiny nut | **Fruit colour:** brown, green | **Bark colour:** green, grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** dark brown
