CHARACTERISTICS

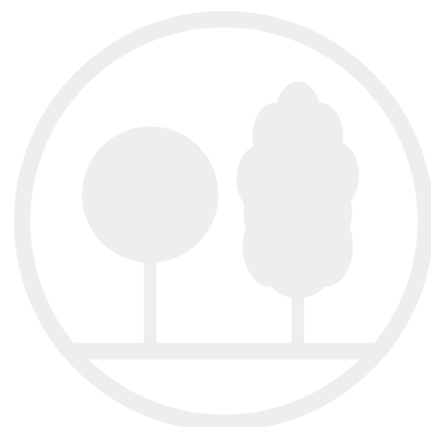
Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 15 - 20 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

Flowers: discrete, small | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, lanceolate, polished, dissected | **Autumn colour:** brown | **Fruits:** edible, small, spiny nut | **Fruit colour:** brown, green | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** black | **Twigs:** bare
