TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, feathered trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide weeping | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

Flowers: catkins, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** dark violet | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, polished | **Autumn colour:** violet, green | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, edible, small, spiny nut | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** black, violet
