**Tree types:** standard trees, feathered trees, solitary shrubs

### USE

**Location:** park, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

**Crown shape:** rounded, ovoid, wide oval | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 8 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

**Flowers:** catkins, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** violet | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** variegated white, red-brown, underside red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, polished | **Autumn colour:** red-brown | **Fruits:** edible, small, spiny nut | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** black, red | **Twigs:** bare
