TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, small mammals

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: catkins, discrete, pendulous, small | **Flower colour:** violet | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds red, dark red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, lacinate, undulate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** brown | **Fruits:** edible, small, spiny nut | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown-violet | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, extensive
