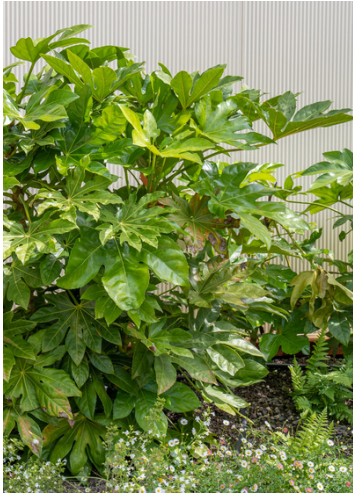




Fatsia japonica



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 8A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: heads, spherical, striking, standing, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** October - November | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, palmate, big, leathery, polished, smooth, hairy, dissected | **Fruits:** striking, raceme, berry | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** green | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, fleshy roots
