USE

Location: street, avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 15 - 18 m | **Width:** 9 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** violet, green | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green, underside white-grey | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, polished, underside hairy, serrate, pinnate, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow, red-violet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth, corky | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
