USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: panicle, discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** bright green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow, orange-red, red | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, extensive, many hair roots
