**Tree types:** standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

### USE

**Location:** avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, countryside | **Pavement:** none, open

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 13 m | **Width:** 10 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

**Flowers:** discrete | **Flower colour:** violet, green | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, polished, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** furrowed, smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare, thickly branched | **Root system:** deep, shallow, extensive, highly branched, tap root
