### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** standard trees, half-stem trees

### USE

**Location:** park, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 0, pollen value 1 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowering period:** non-flowering | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, rough, pinnate, composite, curly | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** yellow, grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** yellow, grey | **Twigs:** bare
