TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees | **Topiary on stem:** pollard, multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: avenue, park, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 14 - 16 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 0, pollen value 1 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete, small | **Flower colour:** yellow-red | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** buds yellow, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** striking, winged, small | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** yellow, brown | **Twig colour:** yellow
