**Tree types:** standard trees, half-stem trees

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** weeping | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 0, pollen value 1 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** corymbose, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** yellow-red | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, winged | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** green, grey
