USE

Location: street, avenue, square, car park / parking lot, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, not susceptible to ash dieback

Flowers: panicle, striking, big, scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate, pinnate, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, winged, small, raceme, nut | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
