Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, conifers

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 15 - 25 m | **Width:** 4 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: catkins, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds yellow, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, flabellate, lacinate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-orange | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** yellow-green | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
