Tree types: conifers, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 5 - 6 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, flabellate, lacinate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** yellow-green | **Bark:** corky | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
