TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, humans, nectar value 2, pollen value 2

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: bell-shaped, striking, pendulous | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** striking, winged, edible, drupe | **Fruit colour:** grey-brown, green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown, grey-black | **Bark:** peeling, deeply furrowed, furrowed, striped | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare, striped | **Root system:** deep, highly branched
