Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone, windbreak, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, sand | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: striking | **Flower colour:** pink-violet | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, lanceolate, composite | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, pod | **Fruit colour:** cinnamon-brown | **Bark colour:** pale grey | **Bark:** smooth, striped | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** thorned
