TYPES OF PLANTING

Other types of planting: undergrowth, ground cover, grasses and bamboos

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.4 - 0.5 m | **Width:** 0.6 - 0.6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: spikes, discrete | **Flower colour:** golden yellow, yellow, yellow-green | **Flowering period:** July - October | **Leaf colour:** bright yellow, yellow-green, bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow, smooth | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-brown, brown | **Fruits:** discrete | **Twig colour:** brown, green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, slightly branched, fine roots, root suckers, roots push up surface,
