Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 1.5 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.8 - 7.7) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: infundibular, striking, half filled | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** buds yellow, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare, vertical branches | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched
