Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 9A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies

Flowers: star-shaped, striking, singular, scented | **Flower colour:** white, red | **Flowering period:** July - August | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, big, hairy, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown, green | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, fleshy roots
