USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** light clay, sand | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, Nitrogen fixing | **Fruits:** small, berry | **Fruit colour:** yellow, green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** slightly thorned
