USE

Location: park, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

Flowers: umbels, striking, big | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, wide, serrate | **Autumn colour:** pale yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
