TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 0.5 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 0.5 - 1.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: bowl-shaped, rosette-shaped, striking, big | **Flower colour:** yellow, yellow-orange | **Flowering period:** June - October | **Leaf colour:** blue-green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** semi-evergreen, lanceolate | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, extensive
