USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 1.2 m | **Width:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.5 - 7.8)

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, flat, striking, standing | **Flower colour:** pink, pink-violet, blue | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, obovate, ovoid, polished, dentate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels, polished | **Root system:** shallow, compact, slightly branched
