USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.15 - 0.5 m | **Width:** 0.2 - 0.3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: trumpet-shaped | **Flower colour:** violet | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** bright green | **Leaves:** lanceolate, narrow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Root system:** compact, fine roots
