USE

Location: in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 12 m | **Width:** 1 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, striking, big | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, wide, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow, orange | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
