**Tree types:** half-stem trees, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 1.5 - 2.5 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

**Flowers:** panicle, stuffed | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, polished, underside hairy, serrate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, red, scarlet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** hairy | **Root system:** deep, highly branched
