TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 1 - 2 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, striking, big | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** July - August | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, big, underside hairy, lobate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, red-violet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy
