TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, climbing plants

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete, singular | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, leathery, polished, prickly, dentate | **Fruits:** striking, toxic, small, berry, drupe | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** green, grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** violet | **Twigs:** bare
