TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: half-stem trees, feathered trees, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 7 m | **Width:** 2 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies, owls | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, small, scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate, thick, leathery, polished, prickly, dentate | **Fruits:** striking, toxic, small, berry, drupe | **Fruit colour:** yellow | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
