



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: half-stem trees, feathered trees, solitary shrubs | Other types of planting: undergrowth

USE

Location: park, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement**: none | **Planting concepts**: Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | Crown structure: dense | Height: 5 - 7 m | Width: 2 - 5 m | Winter hardiness zone: 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: butterflies, owls | Extreme environments: tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, discrete, small, scented | Flower colour: cream-white | Flowering period: May - May | Leaf colour: dark green | Leaves: evergreen, lanceolate, thick, leathery, polished, prickly, dentate | Fruits: striking, toxic, small, berry, drupe | Fruit colour: yellow | Bark colour: grey | Bark: smooth | Twig colour: green | Twigs: bare
