TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth | **Topiary on stem:** pleached

USE

Location: park, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies, owls | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete, small, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, thick, leathery, polished | **Fruits:** striking, toxic, small, berry, drupe | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** violet, green | **Twigs:** bare
