TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** ground cover | **Topiary:** globe, bowl, block

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete, tiny, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovate, lanceolate, thick, leathery, polished | **Fruits:** discrete, toxic, small, berry, drupe | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** green, grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red, green, grey | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, extensive
