Soil: loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: raceme, striking, tiny | **Flower colour:** dark pink | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate | **Fruits:** discrete | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown
