Location: park, large garden | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 1 - 2 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees
