TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 7 - 15 m | **Width:** 7 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 4, pollen value 4 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: panicle, striking, big | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** August - September | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, matt green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, big, serrate, pinnate, bipinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange | **Fruits:** striking, large, capsules | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale grey | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels, horizontal branches, pendulous, long shoots | **Root system:** shallow, coarse roots, fleshy roots
