**Tree types:** standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, conifers, woodland planting stock | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 25 - 45 m | **Width:** 12 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
