Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** pyramid, cone

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 12 m | **Width:** 8 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 8A - 11B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral

Flowers: panicle | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, narrow, leathery, polished, scented with contusion | **Fruits:** small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** yellow, brown
