



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 1 - 2 m \mid Width: 2 - 3 m \mid Winter hardiness zone: 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral | Host plant/forage plant: bees

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking, small | Flower colour: pink-violet | Flowering period: August - September | Leaf colour: green, underside greygreen | Leaves: deciduous, ovoid, underside hairy, ternate | Autumn colour: yellow | Fruits: discrete | Fruit colour: brown | Bark colour: green | Bark: furrowed | Twig colour: green | Twigs: hairy
