USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery, windbreak, coastal area | **Pavement**: none | **Planting concepts**: Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | Crown structure: dense | Height: 2 - 3 m | Width: 1.5 - 2 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, nectar value 4, pollen value 4 | Extreme environments: tolerant to salt spray

Flowers: panicle, singular, strongly scented | Flower colour: cream-white | Flowering period: July - July | Leaf colour: variegated yellow, green | Leaves: semi-evergreen, ovate | Autumn colour: violet, green | Fruits: toxic, drupe | Fruit colour: black | Bark colour: grey-brown | Bark: smooth | Twig colour: green | Twigs: bare
