Location: street, avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 12 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (4.5 - 7.5)

Flowers: spikes, discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** variegated white, grey-green, variegated silver, Variegated leaf | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, polished, lacinate, serrate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-orange, red-violet, pink | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare, horizontal branches | **Root system:** deep, extensive, fleshy roots, central root
