Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Planting concepts:** urban planting, shade-tolerant, Eco planting

Height: 1 - 2 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (4.5 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 4, pollen value 4 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: singular, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green, dark green | **Leaves:** semi-evergreen, lanceolate | **Autumn colour:** brown, red-brown, red, bronze-red | **Fruit colour:** black | **Twig colour:** red-brown, black | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched
