Height: 2 - 5 m | **Width:** 2 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 10B

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 4, pollen value 4 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
