Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover

USE

Location: park, central reservation, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting, shade-tolerant

Height: 0.5 - 1 m | **Width:** 0.5 - 1 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovate, small, polished, smooth | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, small, aromatic, berry | **Fruit colour:** violet | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** violet, green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, highly branched
