USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.3 - 1 m | **Width:** 0.15 - 0.3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.1 - 8.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies

Flowers: corymbose | **Flower colour:** brown, pale grey | **Flowering period:** April - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate, grassy | **Fruits:** discrete, capsules | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Twig colour:** green | **Root system:** shallow, compact, many hair roots, fine roots
