USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.6 - 1 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking, half filled | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, leathery, polished, leaf thorns, dentate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** small, frosty, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown
