Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

Flowers: raceme, standing, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** red-green, green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, leathery, prickly | **Autumn colour:** bronze-red, violet | **Fruits:** small, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare
