TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline (7.2 - 8.2) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: striking, singular, big | **Flower colour:** pink-red | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, edible, small, crabapple/ornamental apple | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** with lenticels | **Root system:** deep, shallow
