TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** curiosity

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: tulip-shaped, striking, standing, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white, pink-violet, red-violet | **Flowering period:** February - March | **Leaf colour:** matt green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, lanceolate, slightly hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-brown | **Fruits:** striking, large, raceme | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** pale grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-green | **Twigs:** bare, vertical branches | **Root system:** deep, shallow, fleshy roots
