TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: street, square, park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking, small, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, big, underside hairy, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, red | **Fruits:** striking, small, crabapple/ornamental apple | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
